10:00 – noon Members of NELL will be visiting the Lightship Nantucket at its berth

In the Boston Harbor Shipyard & Marina, 256 Marginal Street, East Boston, MA.

NELL did visit the Nantucket several years ago when it first came to Boston Harbor.

In 2012 the Nantucket Lightship/LV-112 was designated a National Treasure.

Although the renovations of the Nantucket is a work in progress, much has been done since we were last there.

NELL has given 2 grants to the Lightship to help with this work.

In recent years the Nantucket Lightship/LV-112 has become a floating museum and learning center for the general public, chronicling the maritime history of the U.S. Lightship Service from its inception in 1820 to its end in 1985.

While visiting the ship, NELL members will have an opportunity to see all the restoration that has been accomplished – as well as learn what still needs to be done.

There are also many exhibits aboard that illuminate the importance of the U.S.

Lightship Service and its historic relevance to transoceanic commerce and transportation.

Arrive at the ship any time between 10 and 12 – allowing yourself enough time to enjoy your visit. You will also find many photographic opportunities both on board and around the ship.

Noon – 2 PM – Find your way to the Coolidge Corner neighborhood of Brookline where you will find a variety of restaurants for lunch, coffee shops, a great bookstore. JFK birthplace is in the neighborhood. The house is closed to visitors for the season – but you can drive down Beals Street and see his home at #83.

2:00 PM – 4:00 PM Program: "History of the Lightship Service, 1820 – 1985"

Robert Mannino, Jr will be our speaker. Bob is the president of the United States Lightship Museum, Inc, the 501©(3) organization that currently owns the Nantucket/LV-112.

We will have our **Hot Chocolate and the Cookie Challenge** again – Hot beverage to be provided but please bring extra cookies to share – and at least one copy of the recipe (without your name on it) to put near the cookies for those concerned about ingredients.

We will be inviting the public to the afternoon program. The Senior Center will help us publicize the event. This program will introduce NELL and the Lightship/LV-112 to many new people.

There is limited street parking on Winchester Street but there are parking lots on Fuller Street and Centre Street – just a short walk from the Senior Center.

COST: \$15.00/person – this includes a donation to the Lightship and for the use of the Senior Center.

Please RSVP by January 8th – so help us in the planning.

Include your email, whether you are bringing cookies and best telephone number – in case there is a need for a last minute cancellation due to weather.
