9:30 a.m. Arrive at Custom House 150 Bank St, New London, CT

Be assigned to a group of five individuals who will be shuttled to New London Harbor Lighthouse (aka 'Pequot' Light) for a twenty---minute visit and climb up the 119 steps of the tower. This is the oldest & tallest lighthouse on Long Island Sound and from the lantern room one can see an amazing number of lighthouses. This is the fourth oldest lighthouse station in the United States (est. 1760, current tower 1801) and still has the $4^{\rm th}$ order Fresnel lens that was added in the mid nineteenth century.

THERE WILL BE MULTIPLE SHUTTLES OF 5 PEOPLE LEAVING FROM THE CUSTOM HOUSE SO WHEN ONE GROUP IS FINISHED THE NEXT GROUP WILL BE AT THE LIGHTHOUSE READY TO VISIT & CLIMB

9:30 – 12:45 p.m. Enjoy the many displays at the Custom House Museum and Gift Shop; NELL's Tom Pregman will be showing films of Lighthouse Trips that NELL has taken or may take in the future; or grab a bite to eat at one of the many downtown eateries in New London.

1:00 p.m. Elinor DeWire presents *Women Lightkeepers* and will sign some of the many books she has authored.

Following Elinor's presentation we will enjoy the cookies baked by fellow NELL members along with Hot Chocolate and Tea. Cookies will be judged and prizes given out for the top three.
